The main body of the report should contain the results. The structure of this part should follow a line of presentation and argumentation that is logical, grammatically correct, technically correct and concise ($\approx 10-11$ pages).

4 Conclusion and Future Work

The report should conclude with a summary of the results (≈ 1 page).

5 References

List the related works.
