CHALLENGE 1: How Can We Define "Literature"?


Important: There is *no all-encompassing* definition!

Most basic classifications:

- Literature is a form of expression of either individual creativity or critical imagination in a certain language.
- Literary texts appear in a variety of media: print, handwriting, speaking, singing, or even film.
- Literary texts can be categorized according to their genre, defined either by a particular form, style or purpose.

WHAT IS THE LITERARY CANON?

"set of literary works that experts and historians view as being important in furthering education and understanding" (Meyers 84)
