University elections

- Annual election of student representatives \rightarrow June/July 2024
- Who will be elected?
 - The new student representatives
 - The student parliament
 - The student senators
- Who can vote?
 - Enrolled students
 - Anyone and everyone can vote, but only their own student council
 - Student parliament and senators are cross-faculty
- Why is voting important?
 - Active and democratic participation in your own student life
 - Opportunity to support certain initiatives (e.g. more choice of food in the canteen)



- Consisting of two to three professors from the department
- Responsibilities include approvals for:
 - Extension of examination time (e.g. compensation for disadvantages)
 - Hardship application for repeat examinations
 - Extension and suspension of deadlines for Bachelor's and Master's theses
 - Extension of study time
 - Theses outside the faculty



Training recognition

- If you did vocational training before your studies and your current studies require an internship, you can have the training period credited as an internship
- Contact the Academic Advisor for Sociology (Mrs. Sachse-Thürer) or the Central Student Advisory Service of the University



Academic Advisor for Sociology

- The Academic Advisor for Sociology (Mrs. Sachse-Thürer) will help you with anything that the Student Council can no longer help with.
- You can ask your student advisory service any questions you may have about your degree program



- A stay abroad period is compulsory in some degree programs, but can also be completed voluntarily in others
- Both a study abroad program and an internship abroad are possible



The university and faculty

The University of Bamberg has around 13,000 students divided into four faculties

- GuK Humanities and Cultural Studies
- HuWi Human SciencesWIAI Business and Applied Informatics
- SoWi Social and Economic Sciences
- The Faculty of SoWi consists of 8 Bachelor's and 11 Master's degree programs in 6 departments as well as 49 chairs and professorships (University of Bamberg - Faculty of SoWi)
