
'Pretty': adverb vs. adjective – using COCA



- 1. Before you carry out your search, you should know that COCA uses the 'Claws7' tagset. http://ucrel.lancs.ac.uk/claws7tags.html
- 2. Click 'CLICK TO SEE OPTIONS' to open the options menu.




- 3. After opening the options menu, select 'NONE (Show POS)' in the 'GROUP BY' drop down menu.
- 4. Search for 'pretty' by typing in 'pretty' to open a list containing the results for the different parts of speech (labeled with tags → use the previously introduced 'Claws7'-tagset to "translate" the tags).
- 5. 'Pretty' can be encountered in the function of different parts of speech. The list posted above shows the frequency for the different search results (total frequency: 74017).
- 6. Click 'POS LIST' (on the left-hand side of the menu) to open another drop down menu. Select 'adv.ALL' to search for 'pretty' as and adverb (choose 'adj.ALL' for adjectives). You could do the same for any part of speech. Your search field should look like this: pretty.[r*] (mind the dot; otherwise you would search for 'pretty' followed by an adverb!).
 - → total frequency as an adverb: 59338 / total frequency as an adjective: 14665

→ there are ambiguous cases (registered as adverbs and adjectives)



7. In order to receive informative bar charts, change the setting to 'CHART' and click 'SEARCH' again. The chart contains information about the frequency of 'pretty' in spoken language, written language etc.
