Project A16) Regional variation of idioms (BNCweb + COCA via CQPweb)

Corpora:

British National Corpus (BNC), Corpus of Contemporary American English (COCA)

Programs:

BNCweb, CQPweb (different name, different colour, but virtually the same interface)

Tasks:

- Find all occurrences of both a drop in the bucket and a drop in the ocean in both corpora
- Compare the relative percentages of the above mentioned idioms.
- Use the collocation function of BNCweb/CQPweb to find out whether there are other common collocations for a drop in the.

Notes:

- The corpora can be accessed via the departmental server: https://engling.uni-bamberg.de/
- You have to sign up for a free user account to gain access to the corpora.

The database delivers the results on a page as follows:





3) Repeat the steps for the idiom "a drop in the ocean"





4) Access the Web interface to the Corpus of Contemporary American English, enter the idiom "a drop in the bucket" into the query box and hit the button Start Query.






5) Results:

A DROP IN THE BUCKET:


- BNC: frequency 0.04 instances per million words
- COCA: frequency 0.34 instances per million words
 - → More frequently used in American English

A DROP IN THE OCEAN:

- BNC: frequency 0.17 instances per million words
- COCA: frequency 0.04 instances per million words
 - → More frequently used in British English
- 6) To find out whether there are other common collocations for a drop in the, access the Web interface to the British National Corpus, enter "a drop in the" into the query box and hit the button Start Query.




7) When this result page can be seen, click on the arrow next to *New Query* and choose the option *collocations*.



8) Hit the button Submit.



9) Using the option *Collocation window span*, you can select how many words to the left and the right of your entered query are included in the search/ results. In this case, the word following "a drop in the" is of interest. Hit the button *Go!*.



10) Results:

Based on the search results of the BNC, it seems that there are no other collocations with "a drop in the" used in British English.
